

## City Purchases Replacement Blower

The Minden City Council moved quickly through a full agenda during their February 5 meeting. Mayor Ted Griess began the meeting by commending City employees for clearing streets so quickly after the last snowfall.

Olsson Associates was hired by the City to engineer the replacement of a blower at the Wastewater Treatment Plant. Utilities Superintendent Ryan Hurst presented their assessment as well as equipment bids received.

Hurst recommended purchasing the Gardner Denver Excelsior Blower Systems blower package and VFD. In addition to being on the low end of the bids, the blower is bigger and offers the chance for \$1,650 annual savings in electrical costs. The council approved the WWTP blower replacement for approximately \$49,690.
